The medieval Stowford Manor Farm in Wiltshire hosts the Hub whose workshops form part of a complex of farm buildings that include a spacious seventeenth century barn. The farm has on-site B&B, camping, delicious cream teas and sits in a picturesque river valley a few miles from the Roman city of Bath.

Getting There

BY CAR: Stowford Manor Farm sits on the A366, 2.5 miles west of the Wiltshire town of Trowbridge and about 9 miles south of the City of Bath. There are signs on the main road and ample parking. Google maps link - <https://goo.gl/maps/C2v97WSzXJ12Th1H6>

BY TRAIN: The nearest station is Trowbridge 2.5 miles away with services from London Paddington via Westbury and Bath Spa. Bradford-on-Avon station is 2.8 miles away with services from Bath Spa. There are numerous other services. For information on planning your rail journey you can visit the National Rail Enquiries Journey Planner [Click Here](#). Taxis are available from both stations.

TAXIS: A taxi from Trowbridge Station to Stowford Farm, Wingfield (2.5 miles away) will be about £8 and takes about 7 minutes. You could call Alpha Taxis on 01225 753218 to book in advance or there are usually taxis parked outside. There are other taxis in Trowbridge if you google 'taxis Trowbridge' you could get a price and book.
